

## CAPING A DEER




**STEP 1:** Ensure adequate hide for the mount. Cut around animal's midsection half way between front and rear legs.

**STEP 2:** Cut around legs a few inches below elbow joint.

**STEP 3:** For each front leg, make a cut between cut below elbow and midsection cut.





**STEP 4:** Carefully peel skin from rear to head. Once neck is exposed, but prior to head make cut to release head and cape from carcass.
